What is Blackbullion Futures?

Blackbullion Futures is a free online learning resource, hosted on the award-winning Blackbullion learning platform. It is filled with impartial, engaging and informative learning activities and resources for 16-19 year olds, and their parents/guardians.

Our free resources are designed to help young people explore career paths, financial wellbeing and education choices available after secondary school or college.

How can Blackbullion Futures support my community?

Blackbullion Futures can equip you, your school or college community, with the tools and resources to support progression across a range of pathways.

We recognise that every student is different, there are lots of options, and the information can be overwhelming. Blackbullion Futures is designed to help users navigate those choices. The platform has dedicated content for young people, and their parents/ guardians, which is accessible and jargon-free.

Who is eligible to join?

Any young person aged 16-19 and their parents and guardians will be able to create a free profile and get all of the Futures content. At the point of registration, users are asked a short series of questions that will help them to navigate content that is most relevant for them, based on the information provided.

Schools and colleges play an important role in helping young people manage key transitions – we can help by providing impartial and free resources to ensure clear and consistent information and signposting.





Why are you asking schools and colleges to get involved?

Our aim is that schools and colleges will signpost their students to the platform and it will become a valuable resource in their careers toolkit. We also encourage partner organisations to promote and share content more widely across the school community i.e. with parents and guardians.

If my organisation registers, do we become a pilot organisation? No, not automatically. Pilot organisations are schools and colleges we're asking to support the Futures launch by providing feedback at two to three key intervals during March and July, to help develop new content and improve the user experience.

This will be in the form of completing 2 surveys and/or attending a focus group. We want the platform to reach the broadest audience possible, so we need to understand the experience of delivery in a range of settings across the whole of the UK – which is why pilot organisations will play a pivotal role.

To recognise the important contribution pilot organisations will make, we are offering these organisations access to exclusive content including:

- CPD sessions designed to support careers and progression
- Student masterclasses, run in collaboration with leading training organisations in the country
- Blackbullion Futures founding organisation status (with logo featured on the website)

Regardless of whether or not you are a pilot organisation, you will be able to signpost your students to the platform.

Can I preview the content/ platform?

Yes, you can register for free on the Blackbullion platform. To create your free profile, go to <u>futures.blackbullion.com</u> and add the 'Blackbullion Futures' content pack to access all learning tools and resources available.

The user journey is different for students depending on the information they provide upon registration i.e. if they express an interest in apprenticeships they will be signposted to content related to that. The great thing is, no options are removed, students will still be able to view and compare different pathways to ensure they are making well-informed decisions.





How do my students register?

Your students will need to provide their name, email address and school/college details to register on the platform.

We do not require a school or college-specific email address to register on the site and this is because we can then offer free ongoing support to students who progress to FE or sixth form colleges.

How much does it cost?

All learning resources available through the Blackbullion Futures initiative are 100% free to use, so you can signpost with a clear conscience ;)
